As the Bergamo Center approaches its 50th year some major capital improvement projects are winding down and some are just beginning. The Mansard roof which had weathered close to fifty years had to be replaced this summer. The roof project occurred with minimal disruption to our retreat and conference groups. The new windows in Unit 2 should be complete by the time this newsletter is published.

In September our project will be to install WIFI access points throughout the entire Bergamo Center. In addition to the wiring for those access points wires will be pulled for a new security system to add cameras throughout the building.

Bergamo Jubilee

The Bergamo Center will be celebrating its 50th Jubilee in 2017. Plans are developing and the activities will start late this fall and begin in earnest with the new year 2017. Contacts have been made to some of our longtime supporters and already \$8,000 in jubilee sponsorship has been received or committed.

Invitations have been sent to some surprisingly big speakers and entertainers. We'll see if they accept! In the meantime there is an emphasis on complimenting existing activities that already draw many friends, guests and Marianists to the Center. We will take those occasions to acknowledge long time groups at the center.



We hope this occasion is a year to reflect on the past and dream for the future. We will communicate the plans for the Jubilee as they unfold.

Strategic Planning

A process that initiated in 2013 with an appreciative inquiry of our guests and patrons has blossomed into a new Strategic Plan for the Bergamo Center that begins this fall 2016. The plan has mission oriented strategies, serving also as a Mission Integration Plan that is a valuable guide as we begin our first full year as a Sponsored Ministry under the Marianist Office of Sponsorship. The Bergamo Board of Trustees is reviewing the plan and timeline once again at its Board meeting on Sept. 8 before the plan is launched.

Spiritual Direction/Accompaniment Course at Bergamo



Bergamo Center will be offering a course in Spiritual Direction for those who may be interested in beginning to discern a call to Spiritual Direction. The first semester classes will be

held every Tuesday evening from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. beginning Tuesday October 11, 2016 and ending on Tuesday, December 6, 2016. The second semester will begin on Tuesday, Jan. 10, 2017 through Tuesday, March 14, 2017. A directed retreat will be held giving the students a chance to conduct the retreat with supervision to follow.

The instructors of the class are a team of spiritual directors who have classroom experience as well as many years of experience as spiritual directors.

The cost for the program is \$300 per semester for a total of \$600, plus some miscellaneous expenses for books/optional food, etc.

Prerequisites for the class are familiarity of the scriptures both New and Old Testament, have your own spiritual director and two letters of recommendation from either a Pastor, Spiritual Director, Diaconate or LPMP supervisor. We are excited to bring this opportunity to all in our Archdiocese and Religious communities.


