Ignatian Spirituality Project

The Ignatian Spirituality Project or ISP is a national retreat ministry started in Chicago in 1998 when Fr. Bill Creed, SJ realized that retreats ought to be available to everyone, not just those who had the time and the resources to get away. ISP has grown now to over 24 cities offering over 150 retreats a year. Though the Project has grown, the mission remains the same: to offer the gift of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius to those who might not otherwise get the opportunity, in particular to those who are homeless and seeking recovery.

The Bergamo Center in Dayton was the 9th city to begin offering the ISP Program in 2010. Program Director Barb Kozlowski has partnered with Sr. Therese Laengle, SC in offering these retreats. Some 250 area individuals have benefitted through participation in the program at Bergamo since it was initiated.

A big portion of the day was spent scheduling the many high school groups that constitute over half of our guests at the Bergamo Center.
